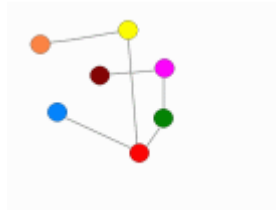
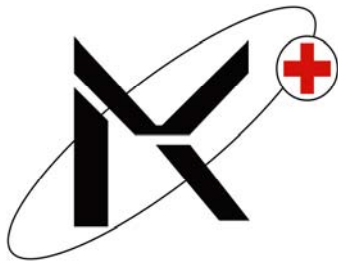
## **I. Introduction.**

During the period March – October 2009 Marie Curie Association organized 4 National and 1 European workshops in order to present the ENEVA project and its successful outcomes. For National workshops we achieve more than 250 attendees from different regions. They are mostly people with disabilities, disadvantaged people, experts in the field of LLL, VET trainers, project managers, policy makers, representatives of National Agency (Human Resource Development Centre), EACEA, Social Platform, POLIS, AGE platform, Universities from UK, Germany, Lithuania, Hungary, Malta, Turkey, Greece, Romania, FYROM National Agency, Hungary National Agency, Ministry of Education and Science, Ministry of Labour and Social affairs, Bulgarian Government, Job centers, Employers organizations, Bulgarian Agency of people with disabilities, National Agency for Vocational Education and Training, Union of blind people, Union of deaf people, Resource center in Pazardzhik, Panaguirishte, Sheltered House in Sliven and Glavititza, Daily care center Plovdiv, National Association Dyslexia, National Association Autism, social carers etc. For more reference attached you can see the list of participants.

## **II. Main points under discussion.**

Each workshop was organized with detailed agenda which described the main points under discussion as following:

- Describing specific needs of people with disabilities;
- Their social inclusion;
- Creativity and innovative products developed for people with disabilities;
- Assistive technologies;
- Awareness rising and Employability;
- Legislation;
- Dissemination and exploitation of the project results – good practice and experience.
- Impact and sustainability beyond the project lifetime



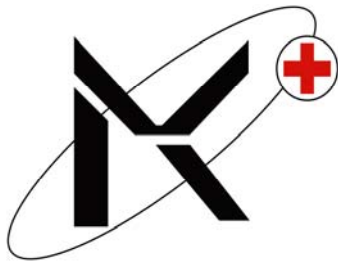
### **III. Presentation of the ENEVA portal.**

The ENEVA portal was presented as a tool which combined key needs of the target group regarding products, training and useful information for the need of the target groups. First of all the speaker on behalf of MCA presented the ENEVA project and its main objectives. Then the web platform was presented with clear view of its main functionalities and availability of resources in each moment of the development of the project. The reason that MCA organized 5 separate events was that the ENEVA project has fruitful development at the last months and a plethora of new products and projects were uploaded during that period and now they are available for usage.

After presentation of the two tutorials (how the platform could be used) the seminars continued with presentation of the projects that MCA uploaded into the platform. Detailed presentation of the available projects was envisaged with the core intention on the available products and possible connection between them.

### **IV. Outcomes.**

As a part of the workshops detailed explanation for the project managers who could upload their own products and products into the portal was elaborated. Also we received useful feedback for improvement of the ENEVA platform which was presented during the transnational meetings in Mulhouse (France) and Grenaa (Denmark) and after them via regular e-mails to the portal administrators. Mostly of the provided comments were regarding accessibility issues, some additional translations which were missing and also some suggestion for the user forum. As a part of the received feedback we discussed the term which could be included in the ENEVA Glossary. For reference see the Forum of the portal.

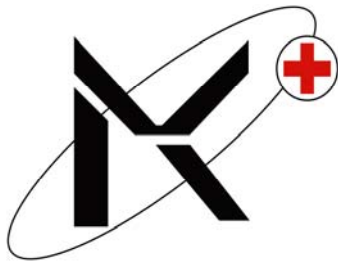


## V. Conclusions.

At the end of each seminar MCA team distributed an evaluation questionnaire for the organization of the seminar. The results were very positive, the attendees were very satisfied from the organization of the event as well as they declared that the information which they received will be very useful into their daily practice. On the other hand the people with disabilities stated the ENEVA portal as very innovative and useful tool which present a plethora of products in different areas, sectors, languages and type of products. They expected also some possible links between similar project and they are looking forward to receive this option in the future.

MCA planned to continue the uploading of new projects and products beyond the project lifetime. Since October 2009 we receive 6 new proposals for uploading and in the next couple of months the team will upload the information of new initiatives. Some of them are transfer of innovation of the previous projects with planned additional enhancement so the connection between the projects will be obvious.

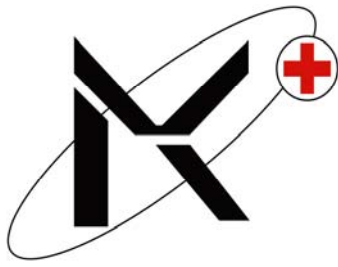
